

# Where to Go

Head west on Highway 90 from New Orleans, tracing the Bayou Teche National Water and Paddle Trail. Explore historic sites and museums in the smaller communities along the way.

Continue on Highway 90. Pass the Chitimacha Reservation and learn about the local sugar cane and lumber industry in Jeanerette. Arrive in New Iberia for a helping of history and delicious cuisine. Take Highway 31 to St. Martinville where you can explore Evangeline Oak Park. Finally, discover the historic district of Breaux Bridge before reaching Arnaudville, the end of the Byway.

**Morgan City Historic District** Front Street to Federal Avenue and Greenwood Street to Railroad Avenue, Morgan City, LA, 70380

Spanning nearly 160 acres and recognized as the first park in the Louisiana State Parks system, the Longfellow-Evangeline State Historic Site highlights the cultural contributions the Acadians, Creoles, Native Americans, Africans, and Europeans had on the region. With a Raised Creole Cottage and a reproduction Acadian Farmstead, the site offers insights into the communities and their way of life in the early 19th century.
