Produces clean burning jet fuel, gasoline, diesel, as well as asphalt for our roads and highways

Produces California
Reformulated Blendstock
Gasoline for Oxygenate
Blending (CARBOB), and
Conventional Blendstock
for Oxygenate Blending
(CBOB) gasolines

Gasoline production is primarily CARBOB, which meets CARB specifications when blended with ethanol

Most of the refinery's products are distributed via pipeline and truck rack
